10 THINGS TO LOVE ABOUT THE ORLANDO



01 Bold crossover styling
Chevrolet's new MPV has a bold look, with its low roofline and crossover-inspired silhouette, while retaining the distinctive and recognizable Chevrolet "face" depicted by the split radiator grille and bowtie badge.



02 7-seater versatility and flexible cargo space
Numerous seating configurations are possible with either the second or third rows folded independently or together to make a completely flat load area. The Orlando's load area is among the largest in the segment, with 1,594 liters available when both rows of seats are folded.



03 Theater style seating arrangements
The Orlando's 2nd and 3rd row are strategically raised to provide occupants a better view both of the front and sides without compromising headroom.



04 Convenience features aplenty
The Orlando is equipped with cruise control, auto climate control, auto on/off headlamps, rain-sensing auto wipers, auto-dimming rearview mirror, and power folding side mirrors for stress-free driving over short or long distances.



05 Ample Storage space
Plenty of storage space is also available for all the bits and pieces that collect inside. The Orlando has a range of compartments of different shapes and sizes and in different locations. There is even a compartment for MP3/music device nestled behind the audio system fascia.



1911 – Chevrolet is founded by racer Louis Chevrolet and William C. “Billy” Durant. **1914** – Chevrolet’s iconic “bowtie” logo is used for the first time. The Model H launches with a durable four-cylinder engine that helps build Chevrolet’s reputation as a dependable car. **1917** – Chevrolet becomes a division of General Motors. **1935** – The Suburban is introduced, offering three rows of seats and generous cargo space. It marks its 76th anniversary in 2011 and is the oldest continually produced vehicle in automotive history. **1953** – The Corvette is introduced. Only 300 of the fiberglass-bodied sports cars are produced that first year, but they launched an American icon that is still going strong nearly 60 years later. **1955** – The ubiquitous small-block V-8 is introduced in the redesigned 1955 Chevrolet line, ushering in a new era in affordable performance and establishing a legacy that continues to this day in the “LS” family of small-block V-8s found in Chevrolet trucks, SUVs and performance cars. **1957** – Fuel injection is offered for the first time. **1960** – Junior Johnson wins the Daytona 500 in a Chevy, the first of 21 Chevrolet victories at NASCAR’s premier race (through 2010)– the most for any manufacturer. **1962** – The Beach Boys record “409” – an ode to Chevrolets powered by the 409 engine, which were burning up the quarter-mile at drag strips across the country. **1967** – The Camaro is introduced, offering a wide range of personalization options, as well as high-performance engines immediately establishing it as a muscle car to contend with. **1975** – The tagline “Baseball, Hot Dogs, Apple Pie and Chevrolet” is introduced. **1990** – The Corvette ZR-1 smashes a trio of speed-endurance records, including averaging more than 175 mph for 24 hours (including pit stops). **1997** – The Gen III small-block V-8 – dubbed the “LS” family of engines by enthusiasts – debuts in the redesigned Corvette. **2007** – “Transformers” is a blockbuster movie that introduced Bumblebee, a character that transforms into a yellow Camaro. **2011** – The Volt is launched, ushering in a new age of electrically driven automobiles with extended range.

Power and Fuel Efficiency

The Chevrolet Orlando is powered by a fuel efficient 4-cylinder 1.8-litre DOHC Dual-CVVT gasoline engine mated to an advanced 6-speed automatic transmission with manual mode. To further enhance fuel economy and response, an electric power steering system is utilized to minimize ancillaries load on the engine.

The Orlando has airbags both in the driver and passenger area. All 7 seating positions are equipped with ELR seatbelt and headrest that provide protection and peace of mind.

Anti-Lock Brake System, Engine Drag Control and Traction Control System

This enables it to sense slipping of the wheels and prevent the vehicle from sliding.
